HEBREWS 5:1-10

## Surrender:

- High priests are chosen among people to offer sacrifices for sins (*v. 1-3*)
- Only God appoints high priests, a role exemplified by Aaron (*v. 4*)
- Jesus, appointed by God, did not exalt himself to high priesthood (*v. 5*)
- Declared a priest forever, Jesus fulfills the order of Melchizedek (*v. 6*)
- Through prayers and suffering, Jesus learned obedience (*v. 7-8*)
- His obedience made him the source of eternal salvation (*v. 9-10*)

## Implications:

- **We are represented** by Christ, our perfect high priest.
- **We are called** by God, our loving and faithful Father.
- **We are saved** by Christ, our obedient and suffering Savior.
