PURPOSE

Genesis 6:5-9 Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. The Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. The Lord said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the sky; for I am sorry that I have made them." But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord. These are the records of the generations of Noah. Noah was a *righteous* man, *blameless* in his time; Noah *walked with God*.

GOD USES PEOPLE WHO ARE AVAILABLE.

- God is <u>not looking for</u> the most extraordinary, talented, or educated.
- God <u>cannot violate</u> our free moral agency, but if we choose to be available, <u>He will empower us</u>.
- <u>2 Corinthians 9:10-11</u> (God will supply and multiply your seed for sowing...)

GOD USES PEOPLE WHO ARE AVAILABLE.

• God doesn't call the qualified, He qualifies the called!

<u>Isaiah 40:28-31</u>, Do you not know? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth... Does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable. <u>He gives strength to the weary</u>, and <u>to him who lacks</u> <u>might He increases power</u>...

<u>Availability</u> is much more important than <u>Ability</u>. <u>Attitude</u> is much more important than <u>Aptitude</u>.

 Are we like Isaiah, saying "<u>Here am I Lord, send me, use</u> <u>me, qualify me</u>"?

GOD USES THOSE WHO WILL OBEY HIM COMPLETELY!




